1) Next is the schedule for the Shonan Bellmare match at Lemon gas Stadium.

Shonan Bellmare will face Kashiwa Reysol on Wednesday, May 3rd. The game will start at 3:00 pm. Admission tickets for unreserved seats are 2,700 yen for adults, and 1,000 yen for elementary, junior high, and high school students.

2) Next is the announcement of the "Star Gazing Party"

From 7:30 p.m. on Friday, April 28th, on the rooftop of the Hiratsuka Local Museum, there will be a "star-gazing party." which is "Hoshi -wo-miru- Kai" will be held.

Let's observe the moon, which has become a half moon, and the stars of spring through a telescope. In case of rain, it will be canceled. The capacity is 80 people. Applicants should apply by returnable postcard by Friday, April 14th. You can also apply through the electronic application system e-Kanagawa.

3) Next is the announcement of the fish market.

On Friday, April 28th, a direct sale of local fish will be held at Hiratsuka Port. JA Shonan sells local vegetables. Dried fish and vegetables are sold from 2:00 pm, and fresh fish are sold from 3:00 pm. It will end as soon as it is sold out. 4) Next is an announcement about a service that allows you to create various application forms on the city's website.

From March 1st, 2023, Hiratsuka City will offer a service that allows you to create various application forms, such as a moving-out notification, with your computer or smartphone on the city's website. 5) Next is the announcement of the "Ryokuka Festival".

A greening festival will be held at Sogo Park for two days on April 29th and 30th. Due to the spread of corona infection, it was not held for 3 years from 2020 to 2022, so this year will be held for the first time in 4 years.
