

1) Next is the announcement of the match schedule at Lemon Gas Stadium in Shonan Bellmare.

Shonan Bellmare will face Nagoya Grampus on Saturday, November 11th. The game starts at 2 p.m. The admission ticket for unreserved seats is 2,700 yen for adults and 1,000 yen for elementary school students, junior high school students, and high school students. There are no reserved seats.

2) The next is the announcement of the test broadcast of J-Alert

In Hiratsuka City, a J-Alert test broadcast will be held around 11 a.m. on Wednesday, November 15th. J-Alert is an alarm system that broadcasts all over the country at once when a major disaster or missile attack is expected.
