

1) The next is the announcement of the match schedule of Shonan Bellmare at Lemon Gas Stadium.

Shonan Bellmare will face Avispa Fukuoka on Saturday, August 7th. The game starts at 7 p.m. The admission tickets for unreserved seats are 2,500 yen for adults, and 900 yen for elementary, junior high, and high school students. Same-day purchases are an additional 500 yen.

2) Next is an announcement from the Hiratsuka City Tax Division regarding the tax payment deadline.

The deadline for payment of the first period of city and prefectural tax is June 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Please make your payment by the deadline. If you are unable to pay by the deadline, please consult the Hiratsuka City Tax Department. The telephone number is 0463-21-8769.

3) The following is a notice of vaccination against *Streptococcus pneumoniae* for the elderly. *Streptococcus pneumoniae* causes serious diseases such as bronchitis and pneumonia, so preventive vaccination is important. People who are 60 years old and older should take the vaccination at a medical institution in Hiratsuka City. The cost is about 3,000 yen. 4) The following is a notice of assistance in vaccination against rubella

Hiratsuka City will subsidize part of the cost of those who receive rubella preventive vaccination until March 31, 2025. The target is women who are planning to become pregnant. However, those who have received preventive vaccination and those who are currently pregnant are not eligible. The cost is 5,000 yen for the mixed vaccine and 3,000 yen for the rubella-only vaccine. Get the vaccination at hospitals and clinics in Hiratsuka City.
