

1) Vaccination Subsidy for Seniors

Hiratsuka City is offering partial subsidies for influenza and COVID-19 vaccinations for residents aged 65 and older.

The program runs from October 1, 2025 to January 31, 2026.

- Influenza vaccine: 1,600 yen
- COVID-19 vaccine: 2,800 yen

2) Fresh Fish Direct Sale
